### DESCRIPTION:

- ⇒ **Traffic Lane** is a single product with a triple use – as a traffic lane pre-treatment prior to extraction, as a low-moisture bonnet cleaning solution and as a spotter.

### USE INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Dilution:**  
Prepare use solutions of **Traffic Lane** in cold water.

Application	Dilution	mL/L	Coverage* sq feet
Pre-Spray or Bonnet	1:10	100	500 – 1,000
Spotter	Undiluted to 1:4	Undiluted to 250	50 – 200

\* Per litre of concentrate

- **Pre-Spray Directions:**  
Remove furniture and vacuum carpet thoroughly. Using a pump-up sprayer, pre-spray stains and traffic lanes with Traffic Lane according to dilution above. Allow to sit 5-10 minutes. Extract carpet.
- **Bonnet Buff Directions:**  
Remove furniture and vacuum carpet thoroughly. Using a pump-up sprayer, pre-spray carpet with Traffic Lane according to dilution above. Allow to sit 5-10 minutes. Use a low speed floor machine with a bonnet to spin clean the carpet.
- **Spotting Directions:**  
Remove excess solids or liquids. Apply spotter, blot from outside of stain to inside using white toweling.
