

TROUBLEGONE BASEBOARD CLEANER

CLASSIFICATION: Ready-To-Use Clinging Baseboard Stripper and Cleaner / Ink and Dye Remover

DESCRIPTION:

- ⇒ **TroubleGone** is an excellent non-aerosol baseboard stripper and cleaner
- ⇒ **TroubleGone** is a non-caustic, non-corrosive, very low odour product.
- ⇒ **TroubleGone** is sprayable from a trigger sprayer, yet thickens upon hitting the surface, providing excellent vertical cling. This provides excellent soil removal from vertical surfaces.
- ⇒ **TroubleGone** is also a powerful cleaner specifically formulated to remove inks and dyes from a wide variety of surfaces.

CHEMICAL AND PHYSICAL PROPERTIES

APPEARANCE: White Opaque Liquid **ODOUR:** Very Low Odour

pH, CONCENTRATE: 8.5 – 9.5 **SPECIFIC GRAVITY:** 1.02

COVERAGE: Approximately 150 linear feet of 4" baseboard / litre (or approx. 600 linear ft per gallon)

USE INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Dilution:** Use in undiluted form.
2. **How to Apply TroubleGone:**

OPTION 1 – Using a Brush:

Pour TroubleGone into a bucket or container. Use a brush to apply the TroubleGone directly on the Baseboard or vertical surface as liberally as necessary. Allow the TroubleGone to sit for 5 minutes or more to achieve soil / wax removal.

OPTION 2 – Using a Trigger Spray:

Although the product is thick, it will thin when stressed during spray to provide good spray coverage. Spray evenly onto surface and allow to sit 5 minutes or as long as necessary to achieve soil / wax removal. The product will thicken on contact and remain intact and wet.

3. Scrub as necessary. Wipe off with a wet cloth and rinse as necessary, or flush to drain.
